

Santa Clara Family Health Plan Receives NCQA Interim Accreditation



Campbell, CA – November 27, 2017 – Santa Clara Family Health Plan (SCFHP) announced today that it has been awarded an Accreditation status of "Interim" by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA), a private, not-for-profit organization dedicated to improving health care quality. NCQA accredits and certifies a wide range of health care organizations.

SCFHP's "Interim" Accreditation status – awarded to its Cal MediConnect (Medicare) line of business – is based on a voluntary review of how the health plan ensures its members are receiving high quality care. SCFHP's Cal MediConnect plan serves individuals eligible for both Medicare and Medi-Cal. Cal MediConnect provides medical, behavioral health, and vision benefits, as well as long-term care, care coordination, and other supportive services.

Organizations awarded this status undergo a new review within 18 months to demonstrate they have executed those processes effectively. SCFHP is now working towards this next level of review – First Accreditation.

NCQA Accreditation is the most comprehensive evaluation in the industry, and the only assessment that bases results on clinical performance and consumer experience. High-performing health plans choose NCQA Accreditation because it is respected by stakeholders, including consumers, regulators, health care providers, and researchers.
